SUPPLIES NEEDED:

1. **YOUR ARTWORK.**
2. **FRAME** at least 6” bigger than your artwork. Example: If your artwork is 10”x12” you will

need a frame at least 16”x18” to allow for approximate 3” mat all around.

3. **ACID FREE BACKING** same size as your frame back opening.

► **ONE acid free mat, wire, screws, etc. will be provided for each participant by CPSA DC202.**
