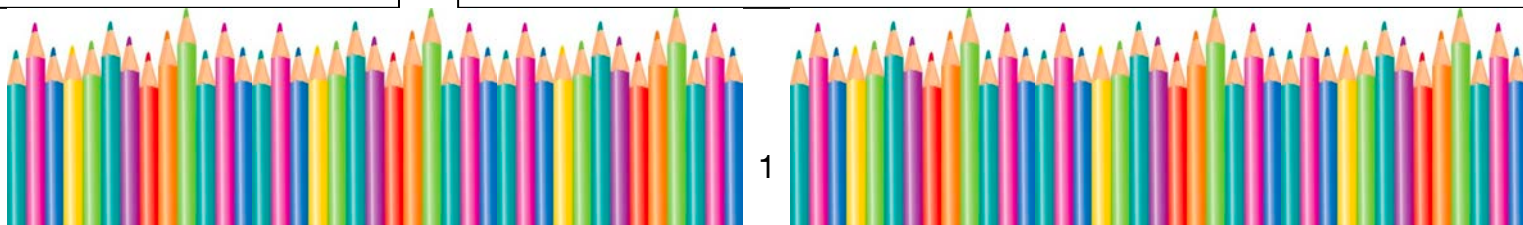
News & Announcements

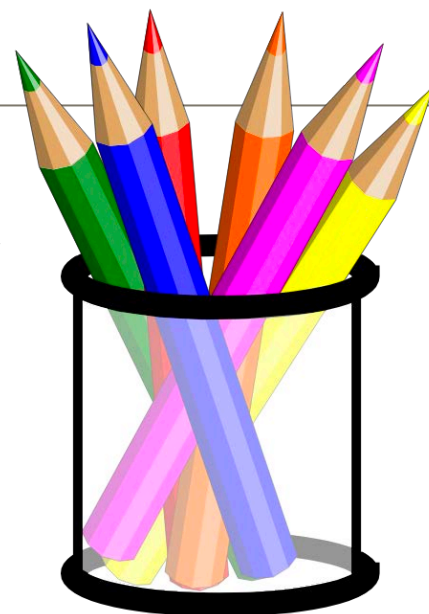
